The Upcoming Final War Gog-U-Magog



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We all get involved in the unusual and frightening current events. Nations are at war with each other and new empires are on the rise. Horrific natural disasters suddenly take place in rapid succession, phenomenal with no explanation or warning. How many such threats does the US Dept. of Homeland Security receive daily? G-d only knows that.

Let us not forget that even without Ossama Bin Laden



blipping any radar screens he still continues to threaten the world. From the Afghan mountains he is menace #1 to world stability. Then, there is Mahmoud Ahmadinejad of Iran who is already rattling the world's nerves even as he is just readying Iran's nuclear capabilities. We cannot delude ourselves when he threatens to vaporize the "imperialist-powers" of the US and Israel. He will be ready to strike way too soon.

One might easily think that the current events are distressing, but a deeper analysis teaches us otherwise.

Why The War Of Gog-U-Magog?

G-d created His world. This includes ourselves, the whole beautiful universe around us, and even the human intelligence to write, to read, and to print these very sentences. But where is G-d, the most important One in the world? He is hiding his presence.

The Hebrew word for world; "olam" has same root letters (ayin-lamed-mem) as the word "He'elem", concealment¹. The One who created the universe concealed Himself, in order to empower man with free will and choice. Talmud Massechet Berachot 6A relates,

"Abba Binjamin states; if the human eye would only be able to see (the spiritual consequences of our deeds), then we would not have the wherewithal to survive."

Should the spiritual forces such as spirits, souls, angels, and destructive forces become visible to the naked-eye then mankind would be struck with such an awe and fright that it would simply not have the 'nerves' to continue living.

G-d took the concealment a step further. A person would



not be able to function *naturally*², if he would immediately see 'positive' G-dly forces being created from good deeds and negative forces also resulting from his sins. Imagine, a man upon performing a Mitzva immediately being rewarded and becoming rich. Further imagine, another person, upon performing a sin he would immediately be punished. Under such a mode of governance man would have no free will. Man would always busy himself with Mitzvot and charity. Only a fool would engage in sin. G-d is 'impressed'³ by the righteous who serve him sincerely.

Consider the state trooper, who observes the traffic from a conspicuously marked cruiser. He knows that motorists only slow down when passing him because they want to avoid any fine. The L-rd therefore 'goes unmarked'- aka: Hester Panim⁴, in order to give humanity a balanced test. G-d's Hester Panim which facilitates man's free-will may even beget the most outrageous blasphemy- Chillul Hashem. Successful people start praising themselves instead of G-d. Some so-called builders of Zion actually never acknowledged G-d for the creation of Israel. G-d's Hester Panim sanctions them to challenge Him for over fifty years while He remains silent.

The Purpose of the War Gog-U-Magog.

Eventually G-d's Hester Panim will cease with the revelation of His divine truth (referenced in Ezekiel, 38-23). Looking towards this period we chant the Kaddish prayer, "Yitgadal Veyitkadash Shemay Rabba." This 'revolution' will not be engendered by a small and local event. Rather, according to the prophets this OLAM, world of denseness and inscrutability will be refashioned through a multi-national, global war, and against Israel. How?

During the end of the second Lebanon war, I gathered my soldiers and told them. "Look, where we have arrived. We are not giving G-d a chance to perform open miracles. Just imagine, during this war. G-d performs undeniable wonders. Within 24 hours we easily win against the trained Hezbollah. and all of Southern Lebanon would be in our hands. And after an additional 48 hours Nassrala would be captured and killed. What would have happened in our state, the day after the war? Israel's salvation will be through the greatest wonders⁶. The deliverance will be as phenomenal as the exodus of Egypt. When the divine truth will finally be distinguished the universe will be governed by new laws of nature.

Who is the leader of Magog?

Who is the likely candidate to be the leader named "Gog"? We may speculate who this might be.
Theologians throughout history offered numerous beliefs and theories regarding the identity of Gog the leader of Magog. However, according to our tradition, we do not know the identity of this monarch, president or leader, nor his nation that will assemble the coalition of the countries against Israel.

The Stages Before The Great War.

1. Destruction of 2nd Temple; 70 CE. Israel sinned. G-d spoke openly to them through His prophets. Nevertheless, G-d provided the forces of evil with a balance of power, thus propping up the resistance. The end result was the masses disregarded the prophets. After unheeded warnings of an impending 'holocaust' the Jewish commonwealth ceased to exist.

2. Diaspora

Israel was disbanded as a nation, and scrambled all over the world, living in small communities. Their mere physical existence was constantly under threat. The Covenant; Daily Recital of Sh'ma (K'riyat Sh'ma) (Deuteronomy 11:13-17)

14: He will give the rain for your land in its season, the early rain and the later rain, that you may gather in your grain, your wine and your oil.

and the will dry out the heavens, so that there be no rain, and the land will yield no fruit, and you will be quickly expelled off the good land which the L-rd gives you.

The Land of Israel- Eretz Yisrael is referred to as "The King's Palace". When being hosted in a king's court one must conduct themselves with proper etiquette. G-d, therefore, advises us about the sensitivity of the Land of Israel. ¹⁰ Upon sinning in Israel, G-d particularly warns us, "The anger of the L-rd will be kindled against you... and you will quickly be expelled off the good land which the L-rd gives to you."

The title of this movie: "Gog-U-Magog" was edited in the format of a military news report. The writer of this documentary subscribes to the former. Our times were predestined by the L-rd as outlined in The Prophets. They might seem bleak. However, we were advised that the world was created with a schematic or master plan. ¹ The concept of "concealment" is expounded by the kabbalists in great depth. In kabala jargon it is referred to as the principle of

"Tzimtzum."

- ² The previous point of concealment was to simply provide humanity with the strength to survive, i.e. so as not to buckle under and perish from fright. G-d took it now a step further, even after we have the wherewithal to survive, He wanted us also to live and conduct ourselves *freely, without pressure.*
- ³ As expressed by the Psalmist, (147:11) "The L-rd takes pleasure in those who fear Him, in those who hope for His steadfast love."

- ⁵ Indeed, major global battles occurred in world history which might have appeared to us and even to leading kabalists as a most opportune time for G-d's unmasking, the revelation of His divine truth. The fact that the revelation didn't materialize then could be attributed to a variety of factors which are beyond the scope of this paper.
- ⁶ E.g. Ezekiel 38:22, "I will execute judgment upon him with pestilence and bloodshed; I will pour down torrents of rain, hailstones and burning sulfur on him and on his troops and on the many nations with him."
- ⁷ An opinion among rabbinic sources maintains that the names "Gog, Magog" are only allegorical. They were ferocious and mighty warrior kingdoms, very familiar to the people living in the days of Ezekiel and were therefore used for "reference purposes only".

- ⁹ There are chilling verses in Ezekiel which make reference that Jews would survive a holocaust and then leave the Diaspora to help in the rebuilding of Israel. For example, see Ezekiel 38:8 with Rashi's commentary.
